

# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

## What are the numbers of students in each level?

Maximum numbers are 26 students in Prep to Y3 and 27 students in Y4 to Y12.

## How many classes will GNLC have in 2022?

Junior Years - Prep to Y5, four classes. Middle Years – Y6 four classes, Year 7 five classes, Years 8 & 9 four classes. Senior Years – Y10, Y11 & Y12, three classes.

## When did our first Year 12 students graduate?

2016.

## How multi-cultural is GNLC?

Our students represent over 50 different nationalities.

## What is the gender split in classrooms?

The target is approximately 50/50 gender split and can vary dependent on applications.

## Does GNLC have a bus service?

GNLC currently operates a bus service to surrounding suburbs such as: Point Cook, Williams Landing, Truganina, Tarneit, Hoppers Crossing, Werribee, Manor Lakes and Wyndhamvale. Speak with the Bus Coordinator for more detailed information.

## Does the College offer before and after care school care?

Services are available for students in P-6 and are run by OSHClub, who in addition to before and after school care, operate holiday programs.
