APPLICATION FEE

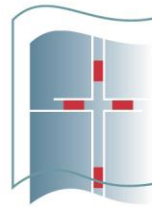
\$125 per child payable upon submitting the Enrolment Application Form. The Application Fee is non-refundable.

ENROLMENT ACCEPTANCE BOND

The Enrolment Acceptance Bond is payable when a student has their enrolment confirmed at the College.

The Bond is held by the College until the student either graduates or is withdrawn from the College. Any outstanding fees or charges owing by the family are taken from this bond and any balance remaining will be returned to the family. This Bond is not refundable if the confirmed position is relinquished prior to the commencement of the child at the College.

FAMILY SIBLING DISCOUNT

For families with more than one child attending the College, the following sibling discounts will apply to the Annual Tuition Fees:

ITEMS INCLUDED IN ANNUAL TUITION FEES AND ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Items included in Annual Tuition Fees

- Excursions and year level camps that are considered part of the student's curriculum
- iPad provided for students in Prep to Year 9
- Laptop provided for students in Years 10 to 12
- Graphics calculators for students in Year 9
- Textbooks and/or online subscriptions and essential stationery for all students

- Music lessons, Canteen, Before and After School Care and Vacation Care Programs
- Levies for VET subjects

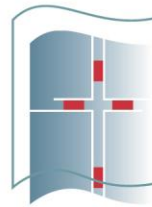
VOLUNTARY BUILDING FUND DONATION

A voluntary Building Fund donation of \$300 per family is requested to assist with the various capital works of the College. This payment is tax deductible upon receipt of the Building Fund donation by the College.

BUS SERVICE

The College has bus services available to and from the College in the local area. Details of Bus Routes and registration forms are available at the Front Office.

- Bus fees are \$425 per term (\$1,700 per annum), pro-rata for part-time users



- Casual trips are \$8 per trip

Bus services are charged per term; no amendments will be made if the bus service is not used for the entire term. The fees for full time and part time bus users will appear on the Fee Statement within two weeks of the commencement of each term. The fees for casual users will be billed at the end of each term.

RENDERING OF ACCOUNTS

Fee Statements are issued by the beginning of each term and are payable within two weeks of the term commencing. Alternatively, a payment plan will need to be arranged to pay tuition fees by direct debit instalments either weekly, fortnightly, or monthly.

Fees can be paid using the following methods:

- **Direct Debit** – The Direct Debit form will be sent to you with your initial account statement, prior to the commencement of Term 1 2023.
- **BPAY** – Each family has a unique BPAY Customer Reference number. This is located on the front of the annual and term fee statement. Good News Lutheran College's Biller Code is 229740; or
- **EFTPOS** – The College has EFTPOS facilities available for payments made in person at the College

Due to administrative costs incurred in following up fee arrears, a charge of \$75 will be applied for late payments that fall over 30 days in arrears, or where agreed arrangements are not adhered to.

WITHDRAWAL FROM THE COLLEGE

One term's notice must be given, in writing, to the Admissions Officer when a student withdraws voluntarily from the College, or one term's fees will be charged to your account. One term's notice is from the start of a term to the end of that term in accordance with the published school dates, excluding school holiday periods.
